- ScottishPower shall, in each case, determine the category of Customer’s condition (Critical Vulnerable / Covid-19 Positive...) and authorise the appropriate level of work activity and control measures, based on this information.**

Operatives will maintain a 2 metre Social Distance from the customer at all times. 	L
All tasks associated with Metering and Energy Supply Equipment.	COVID-19 Virus Transmission.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Infection of employee. Infection of customer. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Operatives will wear appropriate PPE for the work task and household condition throughout the process. Operatives will establish and maintain a 2 metre Social Distance and where practicable also establish segregation from all occupants. Operatives will wipe down work area surfaces and door handles with cleaning wipes prior to and after work has been completed. Operatives will bag and remove all work related waste from site. Upon return to the company vehicle, the operative will remove all disposable PPE and double bag with other waste removed from site. Operatives will clean hands with soap and water or alcohol-based gel and wipes. 	L

Disposal of Waste.	COVID-19 Virus Contact.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Transmission of the virus to employee, customer and the general public. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Operatives will double bag and seal all waste (including disposable PPE). Operatives will mark the outer bag with the date and time of sealing.. Waste bags will be held in the vehicle or other safe place for 72 hours prior to final disposal. 	L
