Statement of Charges for Metering Services

Effective from 1st April 2025

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Introduction

- 1.1. This statement describes the terms and conditions under which SP Manweb offers Metering Services to any person. This statement is prepared by SP Manweb in accordance with Condition 36 of its Distribution Licence issued under the Electricity Act 1989 as amended. Words and expressions used in this statement have the definitions given to them in the Act or Licence and shall be construed accordingly. The Licence requires that the terms and charges contained in this statement will be reviewed at least once each year. Charges and costs shown are current at the time of publication and will not be changed except as provided for in the relevant agreement for metering services and subject to Condition 36 of the Licence, and are exclusive of VAT. This statement has been prepared in a form to be approved by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (Ofgem).
- 1.2. The charges in this statement and in accordance with Licence Condition 36, cover basic Meter Asset Provision provided by SP Manweb.

Persons Entitled to Apply for SP Manweb Metering Services

- 1.5. On application by any person SP Manweb will offer terms for basic meter asset provision and Metering Point Administration Services within its distribution services area.
- 1.6. SP Manweb has a licence obligation to offer certain non-half hourly basic meter services within its distribution services area in the form in which the licence was in force on 1 June 2003. However, these services may also be procured from other service providers.

- 1.7. SP Manweb shall not enter into any agreement if such agreement is in breach of SP Manweb Licence obligations.
- 1.8. In addition to this standard agreement for Metering Services, it may be necessary for the applicant to enter into other agreements such as the Data Transfer Agreement, Use of System Agreement, Retail Energy Code and any other relevant industry code.
- 1.9. If the applicant and SP Manweb within a reasonable time fail to agree contractual terms, or any variation of contractual terms proposed by either party, either party may request settlement by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority. Appointment and De-Appointment

- 1.10. The Company's obligation to provide legacy services does not apply to a given Supplier in relation to metering points at which the supplier has de-appointed the Distribution Network Operator as MAP.

Services Offered by SP Manweb

- 1.11. Where use is made of SP Manweb Metering Services, a charge for use of the services will be levied on the supplier of the electricity. The charges payable in relation to Metering Services will be calculated in accordance with the principles set out below.

Basis of Charges for Meter Asset Provision.

- 1.12. This service is provided on the basis of supplying an appropriate certified meter together with any related timing device or other associated equipment. The charge for this service will be on a pence per meter per MPAN per day basis, as set out in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 of this document. Where applicable, the charges are calculated in line with the price caps and methodologies as set out in the licence.
- 1.13. Meters shall continue to be provided until the end of their useful economic life, i.e., until such time as the meter is replaced or removed.
- 1.14. Calculation of the basic meter asset provision charge shown to be on a pence per meter per MPAN per day will be charged on a monthly basis, based on the meter count per

supplier on the 15th day of the month, regardless of when the supplier acquired the MPAN/meter during a month.

- 1.15. Payment of charges in respect of basic meter asset provision and transaction-based charges will normally be payable in accordance with the billing period and payment terms agreed with the party using the equipment, or in the absence of such agreement, within 30 days for meter asset provision and 14 days for transaction-based charges.

Urgent Metering Services Charges

- 1.1. Urgent Metering Services charges, as specified in Schedule 3 of this document, will apply when SP Manweb receives a request to attend site when a customer's energy supply is interrupted by a fault with an electricity meter.
